Its wipe-on, wipe off formula helps replenish timber exposed to regular washing, leaving it looking refreshed while providing a durable food-safe finish when used directed.

APPEARANCE:	Produces a clear, low sheen finish, enhancing natural timber grain.
SIZES:	250mL
APPLY WITH:	Clean, dry lint-free cloth.
PREPARATION:	Ensure timber is clean and completely dry before application. Remove any surface dirt, grease or contaminants. If raised timber fibres are evident, lightly sand the surface prior to oiling.

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APPLICATION:	1. Apply Woodwipe sparingly to clean, dry timber using a dry, lint-free cloth. 2. Allow the product to penetrate the timber, then buff the surface with a clean, dry lint-free cloth. 3. Allow the oiled item to dry completely in a well-ventilated area before use.
CLEAN UP:	• Wash application cloths thoroughly in hot soapy water and hang to dry to prevent heat build up or self-ignition. • Wipe off splashes from glass and other surfaces immediately to prevent staining
